RULES FOR CHILDREN'S CLASSES

(please read carefully)

1. Intending exhibitors should complete and return the Official Entry Form no later than Thursday 13th. August.
2. All exhibitors to bring entries to Village Hall on Saturday 15th August between 8-10.30 am.
3. All those wishing to keep their entries must clear them from the Hall BETWEEN 5-5.30 pm on the day of the show. Produce left after this hour will be sold for the benefit of the Society. **NO ARTICLE MAY BE REMOVED BEFORE THIS HOUR.**
4. All entries must be grown or made by the competitor.
5. No competitor may enter more than one exhibit in any single class.
6. Division G: Open to children up to school-leaving age.
7. Division H: Open to children up to age 11.

AWARDS

1. The Harris Challenge Cup to the exhibitor gaining the highest prize money in Division G.
2. **NEW AWARD** – The Ashington Junior Gardener Cup + £10 voucher – to the exhibitor gaining the highest prize money in Division H.
